

APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO LIST OF APPROVED MEDIATORS FOR
PURPOSES OF SUPREME COURT RULE 905 FOR THE TENTH JUDICIAL
CIRCUIT OF ILLINOIS

The Tenth Judicial Circuit of Illinois per Supreme Court Rule 905 has enacted a local rule which requires as follows:

All mediators will be required to complete the Bradley Family Mediation Education Course and obtain the certificate of completion by Bradley University, Peoria, Illinois. Any mediator who has successfully completed a mediation course, other than Bradley University, or who wishes certification based upon experience, may submit his/her qualifications to the Mediation board of Bradley University with a \$50.00 administrative fee to determine if the applicant meets the requirements of the Mediation Board. The Mediation Board shall submit their recommendation to the Chief Judge who shall make the final determination as to who appears on the approved list of mediators. The Mediation Board shall be comprised of two professors chosen by Bradley University and the Judicial Coordinator designated by the Chief Judge.

Mediators must meet the requirements of the local rule and agree to mediate annually at least one pro bono and one sliding scale case assigned by a judge. A copy of the local rule can be obtained from Jennifer Ortega, 309-677-6238.
