Marshall County Health Department H1N1 Walk-in Clinics

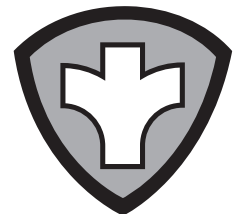

***There are NO PRIORITY GROUPS
and NO COSTS to receive a
vaccination at these clinics.***

- **Any individual under the age of 18 MUST be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.**
- Infants must be 6 months of age to receive vaccine.
- Children age 9 and under require second dose 28 days or more after the first dose.

Individuals should continue to practice preventative hygiene measures; **clean** your hands frequently, **cover** your nose and mouth when coughing, and **contain** spread of the flu virus by **staying home when you are ill.**
