Recognizes the phased approach of Restore Illinois

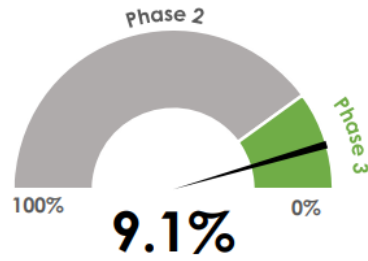
Provides smaller increments of changes to allow less variation in capacity



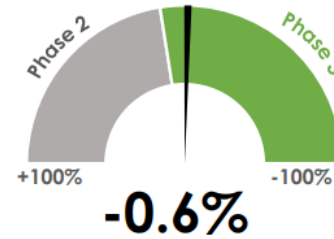
RESTORE IL SCORECARD: NORTH-CENTRAL REGION

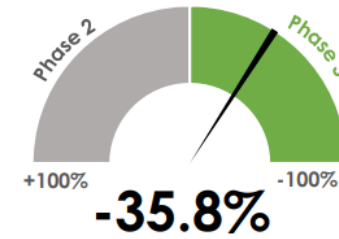
% Positivity



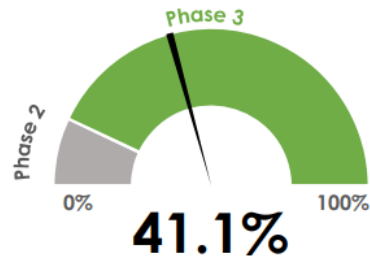
% Positivity Change Last 14 Days



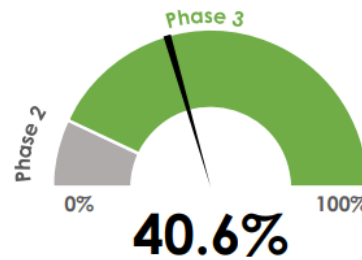
Hospital Admission Change Since May 1



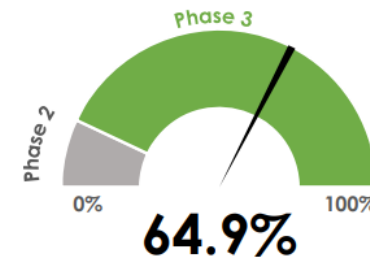
Med/Surg Bed Availability



ICU Bed Availability



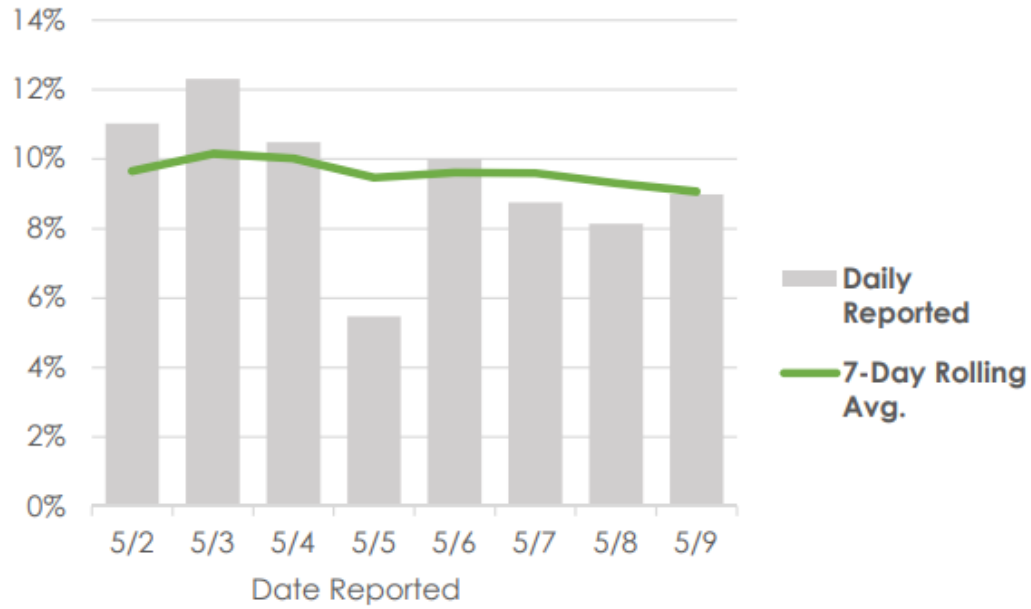
Ventilator Availability



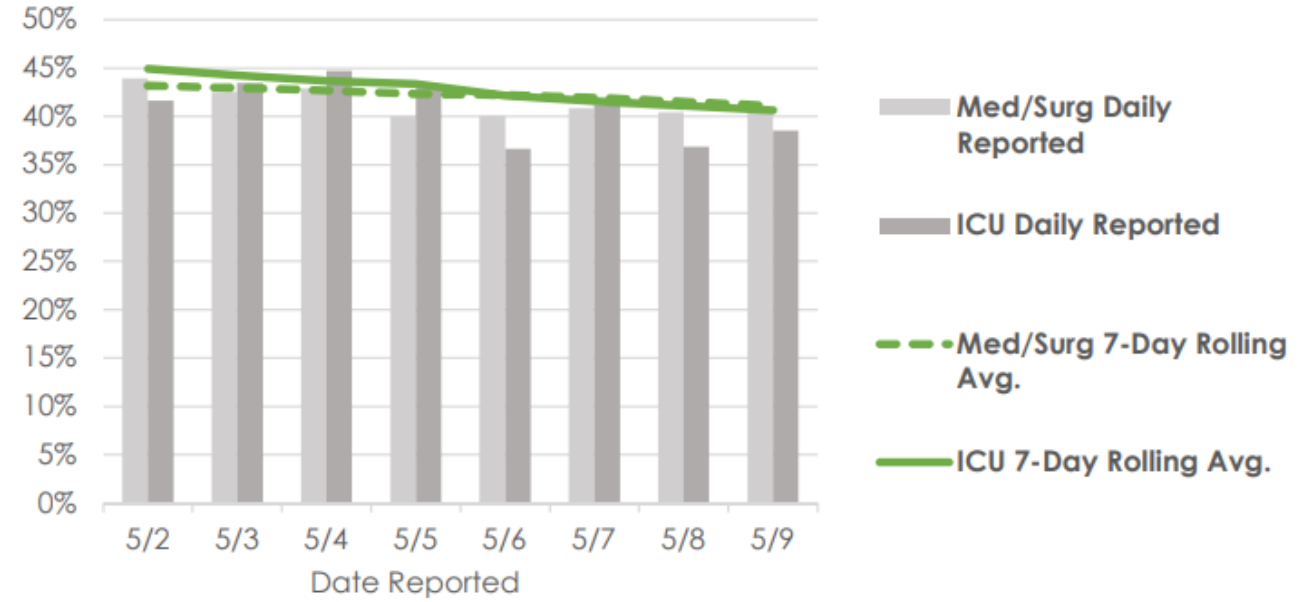

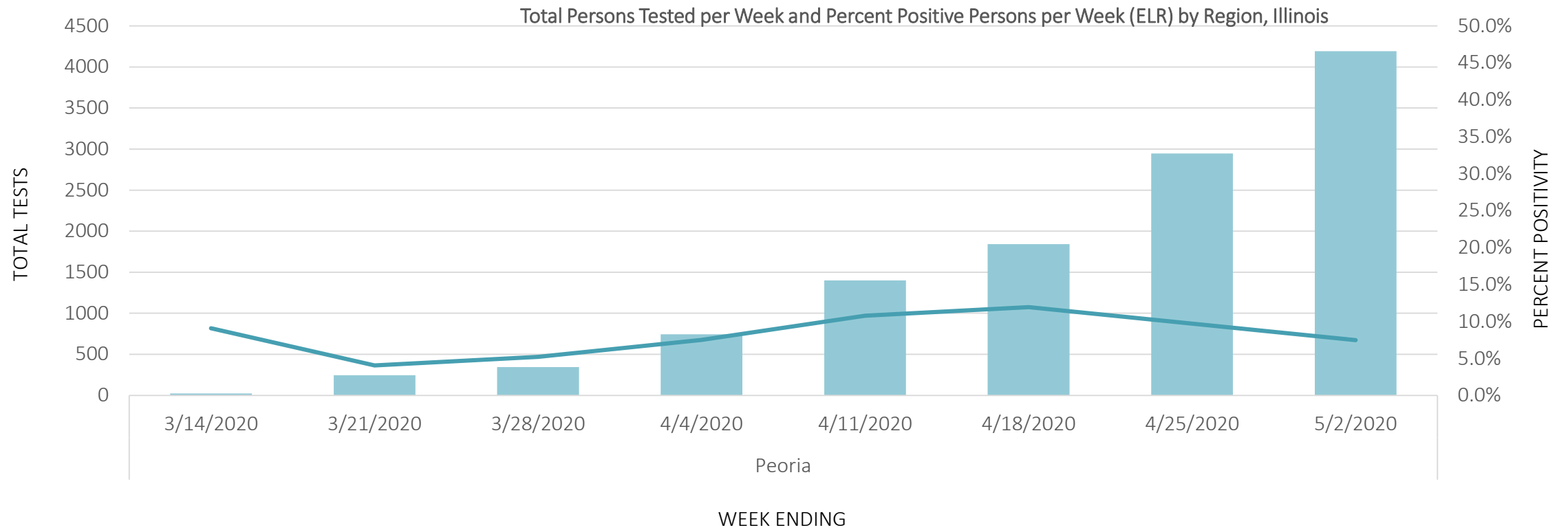

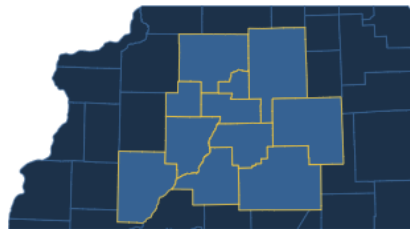
